Summary Background:

The Hyattsville Clean and Safe Team is a pilot initiative intended to demonstrate the effectiveness of hyperlocal work crews to advancing public health and safety. Not inconsequentially, establishing these crews will create employment opportunities and the potential for new hires to gain skills to move into other departments within the City government. Employ Prince Georges has agreed to recruit, hire, train and provide uniforms for the 7 members of the Clean and Safe team.

Next Steps:

The City will work with Employ Prince George's Inc to select 4 full time and 3 part time employees. The MOU between the City and Employ Prince George's is currently under review by the City Attorney. We are working towards a start date (recruiting and initial 12 weeks of training) to begin March 4, 2019.
