BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

At the May 26, 2026, Board meeting, Director David Oro requested an informational discussion regarding emergency access, evacuation considerations, and circulation from a public safety perspective.

The American Canyon Fire Protection District routinely coordinates with local, county, and regional partners to support emergency response, evacuation planning, public notification, and community preparedness efforts. As development continues throughout the community and special events attract visitors to the area, maintaining effective emergency access and public safety coordination remains an important operational consideration.

Discussion

At the request of Director Oro, staff has prepared an informational presentation regarding emergency access, public safety coordination, and evacuation preparedness within the East Side Development Area.

The District's presentation focuses on:

- Existing emergency access infrastructure;
- Public safety partnerships and interagency coordination;
- Existing and future access network considerations from an emergency response perspective;
- Emergency notification and preparedness resources available to residents; and
- Public safety priorities related to emergency response, evacuation capability, and community

resiliency.

Representatives from the Napa County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services (OES) have also been invited to provide information regarding evacuation preparedness, Genasys Protect (Zonehaven), emergency notifications, and countywide emergency management resources available to the community.

This item is presented for informational purposes only. No action is requested. The District does not support or oppose any specific roadway alignment, development proposal, or ballot initiative. The purpose of this discussion is to provide information from a public safety and emergency response perspective.
