BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

The City of American Canyon has a longstanding commitment to supporting local nonprofit organizations that provide programs, services, and events that enhance the quality of life for our residents.

For Fiscal Year 2025/26, the City Council allocated \$30,000 to support the Community Grant Program and directed the Parks and Community Services Commission (PCS) to develop a formal Community Grant Policy. The newly approved Policy (Attachment 21) established the framework for a transparent, equitable, and consistent grant-making process.

The grant application period opened on October 10 and closed on November 14, 2025. The twenty (20) applications received are attached and summarized below:
