BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

The American Canyon Police Department - a division of the Napa County Sheriff's Office – provides high quality law enforcement services to the community needs.

Statistics

The 2025 annual report (Attachment A) showcases all the services provided. A summary of 2025 is below:

- Zero (0) homicides
- Decrease in vehicle theft (39), from (50) in 2024.
- Slight increase in residential burglaries (14), from (11) in 2024.
- Robberies (20) and Assaults (131), slightly increased from (16) and (94) in 2024.
- Significant increase in total arrests (704), from (516) in 2024.
- Total collisions on local roads decreased (66), from (75) in 2024. Collisions on SR-29 increased (78), from (52) in 2024.
- Fatal traffic collisions increased (2), from zero (0) in 2024.
- Responded to 14,923 calls for service, slight increase from 14,776 in 2024.
- Seized (45) firearms in 2025. Which is slight decrease from (50) in 2024.

The California Department of Justice lists the 2024 clearance rate for violent crime at 43.6% and property crime at 7.8%. In 2025 ACPD's clearance rate for violent crimes was 54.1% and property crimes is 40.7%.

(DOJ 2025 clearance rates were not available at the time of this report)

FISCAL IMPACT

In 2024, the City and County entered into a new three-year agreement to continue this service. The 2025/26 contract with Napa County is \$9,759,801.

The current 3-year agreement expires on June 30,2027. The City of American Canyon and the Napa County Sheriff's Office plan for cost projections and anticipated future expenses when drafting these agreements. In the event of significant changes during the term of the agreement, an amendment may be made to reduce or expand the agreement.
