## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt a Resolution endorsing House Concurrent Resolution 46 regarding climate restoration goals.

## **BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS**

On March 3, 2026, Mike Thompson requested that the City Council of American Canyon consider formally endorsing H.Con.Res. 46, a House Concurrent Resolution expressing the sense of Congress that the United States should strive to restore atmospheric carbon dioxide concentrations to preindustrial levels by 2050 in order to help ensure a safe and healthy climate for future generations.

In his correspondence, Congressman Thompson noted that local students and community members, including Napa Schools for Climate Action, have advocated for local government support of climate restoration efforts, and that other local agencies, including Napa County Resource Conservation District and Napa County Board of Education, have taken similar action.

Adoption of the proposed resolution would allow the City Council to formally express support for long-term climate restoration goals and acknowledge community engagement on this issue. The resolution is advisory in nature and does not establish regulatory requirements, create implementation obligations, or commit City resources.
