Annual Fire Inspection Compliance Report for the calendar year 2025

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution confirming 2025 Fire Inspection Compliance Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

California Health & Safety Code Section 13146.2 requires fire departments to conduct annual fire inspections of certain occupancies, including public or private schools, hotels, motels, lodging houses, and apartment building, and certain residential care facilities to ensure compliance with applicable fire and life safety standards. The District is also required to report its annual inspection compliance to the administering authority.

For calendar year 2025, the American Canyon Fire Protection District completed 17 of 20 required inspections, resulting in an 85% compliance rate.

Background and Issues:

California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4, effective as of September 27, 2018, mandates that all fire departments providing fire protection services—such as the American Canyon Fire Protection District—must perform and document annual fire inspections in the following occupancies:

- Group E: Public and private schools
- Group R: Hotels, motels, lodging houses, and apartment buildings

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 13146.2, fire departments are required to annually report to their administering authority the number of inspections required and the number

completed during the reporting year.
