BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

The update of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan (Master Plan) began in September 2024. The process included a comprehensive review of the City's existing parks, facilities, programs, open spaces as well as previous planning efforts through the 2012 Parks and Community Services Master Plan, the 2015 Parks Needs Assessment, and the Clark Ranch Master Plan, the Kimberly Park Master Plan, and Veterans Memorial Park Master Plan.

Key components of the Master Plan update included extensive community engagement and outreach, including stakeholder interviews, a community survey, an open house, and multiple public review opportunities. In addition, the City's 2040 General Plan served as the guiding policy document, providing a long-term framework for parks, recreation, trails, and open space planning in American Canyon. Feedback received throughout the process helped shape the Master Plan.

City staff presented the Draft Public Parks and Recreation Master Plan to the City Council on May 5, 2026. Following consideration of public and City Council input, the Master Plan (Attachment 2) is now presented for adoption. Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the Parks and Recreation Master Plan to guide future investments, priorities, and decision-making related to parks, recreation, facilities, trails, and open space.
