**BACKGROUND:** The Sound to Olympics Trail Sakai Pond Connector project includes construction of a paved shared-use path from the northwest corner of the intersection of High School Road/SR305 to a gravel pedestrian trail on Bainbridge Island Metropolitan Park & Recreation District property, also known as Sakai Park.

Bids were solicited through the MRSC Small Works Roster process, and the City received zero bids at the March 20, 2020 bid opening. Following the no response bid opening, the City negotiated directly with Liden Land Development & Excavation, Inc., with a proposal in the amount of \$186,400.26. The engineer's estimate is \$188,399.00.

Public Works staff recommends awarding this contract for the Sound to Olympics Trail Sakai Pond Connector to Liden Land Development & Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$186,400.26.
