BACKGROUND: In July 2020, the Army Corps of Engineers authorized emergency spot repairs to six sections of the existing failed rock revetment totaling 290 linear feet. The City completed emergency repairs in November 2021 to the portions of the failing revetment it was granted construction access to by adjacent property landowners.

In February 2024, the City received conditional approval for remaining bulkhead repairs contingent upon mitigation requirements. Construction of the bulkhead must occur from August 1, 2024 through October 12, 2024 due to fish preservation concerns. The mitigation will occur over 4 years following the completion of the bulkhead repairs.

The repairs are the maximum that will be permitted by state and federal permitting agencies. City staff do not anticipate reopening the currently closed westbound traffic lane of Country Club Road following the repairs, as the conditions will continue to not be sufficient for vehicular traffic safety.
