SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution 2024-157, Authorizing the Purchase of 10 Additional Getac Body Worn Cameras, Accessories, and Multi-dock Charging Stations

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution 2024-157.

BACKGROUND:

The Banning Police Department strives to ensure personnel are equipped with the most up-to-date equipment for officer safety and transparency with the community. The Banning Police Department currently has 30 body worn cameras and all are deployed with department personnel.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Banning Police Department now has 33 sworn officers and 1 Animal Control Officer/Community Service Officer that are all required to wear body worn cameras while on duty. Due to equipment limitations Lieutenants are not currently issued a body worn camera, to allow for all other staff members to have the equipment. With all current body worn cameras deployed and more officers being hired to fill vacant positions, the Banning Police Department is in need of additional cameras to fill the needs of the department.

FISCAL IMPACT:

An appropriation from the General Fund 001 to Account No. 001-2200-421.90-48 in the amount of \$33,805.67 is necessary to fund the Equipment Purchase with Code 3 Technology.
