SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution 2024-127, Approving the purchase of a 2024 Chevrolet Silverado and All Needed Up Fitting Using PACT Funds in an Amount Not to Exceed \$97,250.00

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution 2024-127.

BACKGROUND:

The Banning Police Department strives to provide a safe community for all residents and visitors to the City of Banning. To help in accomplishing that goal, the Banning Police Department has partnered with several regional multi-agency task force organizations. The Banning Police Department currently provides one sworn peace officer to the Post-Release Accountability Compliance Team (PACT) and looks to add an additional body to the team in the future as staffing permits. Currently the Banning Police Department is supplied with one vehicle to be driven by the member on PACT. Securing a second vehicle while funds are available will allow for additional personnel to seamlessly join the team when staffing is available.

JUSTIFICATION:

The funding for the second vehicle is currently available for use by the Banning Police Department and if not used the funding will go unspent. Deciding not to purchase the second PACT vehicle now would cause a future financial burden to the City when the staffing resources become available.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Revenue has been provided by the Community Corrections Partnership Executive Committee in the amount of \$238,150 in Fiscal Year 2023/24. Reimbursement for a second PACT vehicle and up fitting in an amount not to exceed \$97,250.00 with a pre-approval by the Committee in the amount of \$92,072.72. The approximately \$5,000.00 shortfall will be covered using existing budgeted funds. An additional appropriation request in an amount not to exceed \$97,250.00 in the Fiscal Year 2024/25 account 001-2200-421.90.52 will be used to purchase the 2024 Chevrolet Silverado and do all up fitting for use by PACT member.

ALTERNATIVES:

Do not adopt Resolution 2024-127 and provide alternative direction to staff. The City Council may choose to reject this action, which would result in unused PACT funds already awarded to the City of Banning going unspent.
