**SUBJECT:** Consideration of Resolution 2026-85, Calling for the Holding of a General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026 for the Election of Two Members of the City Council to Four Year Terms Representing Districts 4 and 5 as Required by the Provisions of the Laws of the California Relating to General Law Cities and the Banning Municipal Code, and Requesting Consolidation of the General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be Held on the Same Day

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt Resolution No. 2026-85

**BACKGROUND:**

Per the California Elections Code, a resolution needs to be adopted calling for a General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. Adoption of this resolution must meet the requirements of the California Elections Code and be submitted to the Riverside County Registrar of Voters by June 26, 2026.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

This action is required under Elections Code Sections 330, 10002, and 10403.5.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Staff will budget \$58,300 in FY 2026-2027 for the 2026 election cycle, including advertising all public notices and election administration performed by the Riverside County Registrar of Voters.
