SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution 2024-187, Reciting the Facts of the Consolidated General Election Held in the City of Banning on November 5, 2024 and Declaring the Results and Other Related Matters as Provided by Law

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution 2024-187.

BACKGROUND:

At the Regular City Council Meeting held on June 11, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution 2024-078, calling and giving notice of a General Municipal Election to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The positions on the ballot for this election included City Council Districts 1 through 4, City Clerk, and City Treasurer.

JUSTIFICATION:

Elections Code Section 10263 requires that the City Council “adopt a resolution reciting the fact of the election” and other matters that are enumerated in Elections Code Section 10264 at the next regularly scheduled meeting following the final canvass of votes.

The County of Riverside Registrar of Voters conducted the election at the City’s request and has completed a canvass of the votes. The certification of that canvass is attached to this staff report and is Exhibit A to the proposed Resolution 2024-187.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will be invoiced for the costs of the election at a later date.

ALTERNATIVES:

This action is required by California Elections Code in order to swear in new City Council members. There is no alternative course.
