SUBJECT: Consideration of Resolution 2026-81, Approving a Three-Year Street Sweeping Services Agreement with Sweeping Corp of America Utilizing Sourceswell Contract #111125-SWEP

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution 2026-81

BACKGROUND:

Since 2020, the City has contracted street sweeping services with Sweeping Corporation of America (SCA). These services were originally obtained through a formal competitive bid process and were later continued through Sourcwell. Sourcwell is a nationally recognized public agency cooperative that competitively solicits and awards contracts on behalf of participating government agencies. This “piggyback” procurement method allows the City to utilize an existing competitively bid contract without conducting a separate formal bid process, while still complying with public purchasing requirements. Use of cooperative purchasing agreements helps reduce administrative costs, streamline procurement timelines, and leverage previously negotiated competitive pricing and terms.

To continue providing citywide street sweeping and related maintenance services, staff evaluated the newly awarded Sourcwell cooperative purchasing agreement for these services and determined that Sourcwell Contract No. 111125-SWEP provides an appropriate procurement vehicle for the City’s continued use. The agreement was competitively solicited and awarded to Sweeping Corporation of America for street sweeping, sewer jetting, hydro-excavation, and related public works services and is available for use by participating public agencies through the cooperative purchasing process. The agreement remains in effect through April 6, 2030.

The scope of work includes 340.88 curb miles of monthly street sweeping services for both residential and commercial areas throughout the City. Residential areas will be serviced once per month, and commercial areas will be serviced four (4) times per month. Additionally, monthly sweeping services will be provided to the parking lots of Replier, Roosevelt Williams, and Lions Parks. Services shall include all labor, tools, materials, and equipment necessary to perform citywide street sweeping services. In addition to beautifying the City, street sweeping services eliminate roadside debris and trash, pollutants, and sediments that might otherwise enter the storm drain, assisting the City in complying with the requirements of its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. This permit requires the Permittees to implement litter and debris control measures, such as street sweeping, to reduce and/or eliminate the discharge of pollutants, including trash and debris, from the storm sewer system to Receiving Waters. In addition to standard monthly needs, the scope requires the Contractor to respond to special requests when hazards pose a threat to public safety, such as debris that creates

traffic issues. Street sweeping services may also be scheduled for special events. Routes, service days, and curb miles are summarized in the attached.

The agreement establishes an initial one-year term, effective through June 30, 2027, with the option for the City Council to approve up to two (2) successive one (1)- year renewal terms, not to exceed June 30, 2029.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Public Works Department does not have the required staff or equipment needed to maintain regularly scheduled street sweeping services; therefore, it is necessary to retain a contractor. Upon review, staff determined that SCA has continued to provide satisfactory citywide street sweeping services and that services be obtained utilizing Sourcewell Contract #111125-SWEP.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total contract award amounts to \$164,213.15. Residential and commercial street sweeping services will be provided for \$150,123.55 and funded by Gas Tax Funds, Account 100-4900-431.33-11 (Professional Services). Additionally, monthly street sweeping services will be provided to the parking lots of Repplier, Roosevelt Williams, and Lions Parks, totaling \$4,089.60 and funded by Account 001-3600-461.30-01. Funding for services as needed in the amount of \$10,000 will be determined on a case-by-case basis. A budget for these services will be included in the proposed FY 2026/67 Operating Budget.
