SUBJECT: 5.3.1. Banning Youth Council Appointments

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint five applicants to the Banning Youth Council.

BACKGROUND:

The Banning Youth Council is as an advisory board to the City Council established under Chapter 2.42 of the Banning Municipal Code (BMC). The purpose of the Youth Council is to provide City youth with a vehicle to learn about government, participate in the process of city government, represent and articulate the needs of City youth, as well as advise the City Council on matters affecting the youth and teen population, especially City programs relating to youth and teens.

The Youth Council is composed of five (5) to nine (9) members who are appointed for two-year terms that can be extended once. Currently five (5) positions are vacant due to graduation.
