Background/History:

In November 1979, the voters of the State of California approved Proposition 4, commonly known as the Gann Initiative. The proposition created Article XIIIB of the State Constitution placing limits on the amount of revenue that can be spent by State and local governments. The appropriations limit is adjusted annually based on population and per capita income "change factors". These factors are received each year from the California Department of Finance. Government Code 7910 requires the governing body of each local jurisdiction to establish, by resolution, its appropriation limit for the upcoming fiscal year. Attached for Council review is a proposed resolution to establish the City of Bishop appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2025-26.

Analysis/Discussion:

The appropriations limit of the City of Bishop for Fiscal Year 2025-26 is \$12,535,018.

Economic Impacts:
