Background/History:

Each year the volunteer firefighters host a destruction derby at the Tri-County Fair. This year it will be held on September 1, 2024. The City and Fire Department enter into an agreement with the State of California to put on the derby.

Analysis/Discussion:

The agreement is reviewed by California Joint Powers Insurance Authority (CJPIA) and we follow recommendations about safety and risk management for the City.

Economic Impacts:

The Destruction Derby has a significant positive impact on the community's economy. The Tri-County Fair is a major event each year and the Destruction Derby is one of its star attractions. Many visitors will book hotel rooms for more than one day and will spend time at our local restaurants and businesses during their stay. Funds raised by the Derby benefit both the Tri-County Fairgrounds and the Bishop Firefighters Association.
