Proposed Resolution No. R26-129- Approving a Fire Rescue Department Emergency Services Agreement for Mutual Aid and Automatic Aid between the City of Boynton Beach and Palm Beach County Fire Rescue, for a ten (10) year term commencing on October 1, 2026, and ending on September 30, 2036; providing for an effective date, and for all other purposes.

Requested Action: Staff recommends approval of the Proposed Resolution No. R26-129.

Explanation of Request: Section 252.40, Florida Statutes, encourages and authorizes subdivisions of the State of Florida to enter into Mutual Aid Agreements for the rendering of assistance in emergencies and provides for the extension of government powers, privileges, immunities, and benefits during such assistance.

How will this affect city programs or services? This agreement strengthens both Boynton Beach Fire Rescue and Palm Beach County Fire Rescue's ability to mitigate emergencies that may occur during periods when Fire and/or EMS units may be engaged in other emergency calls, necessitating the need for neighboring agencies to assist. Further, this agreement allows for continuity in Fire and Rescue activities that may occur, which go beyond the capability of either agency.
