Proposed Ordinance No. 24-005- Second Reading- An Ordinance of the City of Boynton Beach, Florida, amending Chapter 9, "Fire Protection and Prevention," Section 9-1, "Boynton Beach Fire Code; Fire Codes Adopted," to update the City Code as required by Florida Statute when a new edition of the Florida Fire Prevention Code has been adopted; providing for repeal of laws in conflict, severability, codification and an effective date.

Requested Action: Staff recommends approval of Proposed Ordinance No. 24-005, on Second Reading.

Explanation of Request: The Florida Fire Prevention Code is adopted by the State Fire Marshal at three-year intervals as required by Chapter 633.202, Florida Statutes. This complex set of fire code provisions is enforced by the local fire official within each county, municipality, and special fire district in the state. The updated version of The Florida Fire Prevention Code 8th Edition - 2023, consisting of the Florida versions of the NFPA 1 Fire Prevention Code, 2021 Edition, and the NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, 2021 Edition, is recommended for adoption by the City Fire Marshal. The proposed ordinance adopts the most recent version of the Florida Fire Prevention Code.

How will this affect city programs or services? Will ensure all fire prevention activities, plan review and fire code enforcement within the city and contractual areas are compliant with FL State Statute 633.202 and provide the most current National Fire Protection Association recommendations for Community Risk Reduction.

Fiscal Impact: There is no fiscal impact to the budget for this item.
