Proposed Ordinance No. 24-004- Second Reading- An Ordinance of the City of Boynton Beach, Florida, amending Chapter 2.5, "Alarm Systems," to clarify Fire Department fees for responding to excessive false alarms; providing for repeal of laws in conflict, severability, codification and an effective date.
