Proposed Resolution No. R26-126- Approve State Forfeiture Donation of \$156,000 - Law Enforcement Trust Fund to the Police Athletic League (PAL) and Explorer Fund and to the following seven (7) Florida 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporations:

- **Trinity Counseling Center of Florida, Inc.**
- **Pathways to Prosperity, Inc.**
- **Men of Vision and Purpose (MVP) of South Florida, LLC**
- **Connect to Greatness, Inc.**
- **Youth Enrichment Association for Academics & Athletic Inc. - Boynton Beach Bulldogs Youth Football Program,**
- **Girl Scouts of Southeast,**
- **Boy Scouts of America**

Requested Action:

Staff recommends approval of Proposed Resolution No. R26-126.

Explanation of Request:

BBPD remains committed to positively influencing juveniles within the community through financial assistance, mentorship opportunities, or employment programs, all of which this donation helps to fund.

These donations fulfill both our legal obligation under section 932.7055, Florida Statutes, and the strategic intent of our department's mission.

Florida Statutes provide that any local law enforcement agency that acquires at least \$15,000 pursuant to the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act within a fiscal year must expend or donate no less than 25 percent of such proceeds to support or operate any drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, or school resource officer program or programs.

The local law enforcement agency has discretion to determine which program(s) will receive the designated proceeds. The donation fulfills both BBPD's legal obligation under Florida State Statute 932.7055 and the strategic intent of the department's mission, as the funds will be used for crime prevention through coaching, mentoring, and the promotion of personal, social, and academic growth.

How will this affect city programs or services? These donated funds will help promote a positive relationship between the community we serve and our law enforcement professionals. These organizations have demonstrated meaningful, positive influence on the youth of our community and have been steadfast leaders in engaging and empowering young people. Their continued dedication to enriching the lives of adolescents makes them invaluable assets to the Boynton Beach Police Department and the broader community.

Account Line Item and Description: Account 691-5000-590-04-25 (Law Enforcement Trust Fund) — **\$156,000** total over three years (current balance: \$618,955.14)

- Year 1 - **\$76,000**
- Year 2 - **\$40,000**
- Year 3 - **\$ 40,000**

Police Athletic League (PAL) and Explorer Program Fund — \$120,000 (Multi-Year Commitment)

Funding will be committed at **\$40,000 annually for (3) three consecutive fiscal years**, for a total commitment of **\$120,000**.

501(c)(3) Charitable Organization Donations — \$30,000

Funding to distribute **\$30,000** in donations to the following five (5) qualifying 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations:

- Trinity Counseling Center of Florida, Inc. - **\$6,000**

- Boy Scouts of America - **\$3,000**
- Girl Scouts of Southeast - **\$3,000**
