Proposed Resolution No. R26-076- Approve a Piggyback Agreement between the City of Boynton Beach and TD SYNEX Corporation for Cyber Security Solutions and Services, for an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 annually; and for all other purposes.

Requested Action: Staff recommends approval of Proposed Resolution No. R26-076.

Explanation of Request: The Innovation and Technology Solutions (ITS) regularly procures technology hardware and software from TD SYNEX and its authorized resellers. At this time, the City intends to make an initial purchase from BlueAlly Technology Solutions, an authorized reseller, on behalf of the Utilities Department.

Approval of this piggyback agreement will allow the City to continue procuring technology hardware and software in compliance with the City of Boynton Beach Procurement Policy. Purchases may include, but are not limited to, computers, monitors, network switches, and network testing equipment.

This purchase will be made under the Piggyback Exemption authorized by the City's Purchasing Policy. Piggyback contracts provide significant value to the City of Boynton Beach by offering a cost-effective, efficient procurement method. Leveraging contracts competitively awarded by other governmental entities allows the City to avoid issuing its own formal solicitation, which can be time-consuming and resource-intensive. This process accelerates access to needed goods and services while benefiting from favorable pricing achieved through economies of scale. Additionally, piggyback agreements utilize vendors who have already undergone a rigorous competitive evaluation, reducing administrative workload and mitigating risks associated with vendor performance. Overall, piggyback procurement streamlines operations, saves taxpayer dollars, and supports timely and effective service delivery for City departments and residents. Negotiations yielded pricing more favorable than the piggyback contract rate, producing additional savings for the City.

How will this affect city programs or services? This piggyback agreement will enable City departments to obtain necessary technology hardware and software from TD SYNEX throughout the year, supporting operational efficiency and continuity of services.
