Proposed Resolution No. R26-136- Awarding Invitation to Bid No. 26-051B for the Campanelli Blvd. - Gateway Blvd. Stormwater Cured-In-Place Piping project to Cobra Environmental, Inc., and approving a Construction Contract between the City and Cobra Environmental, Inc., in the amount of \$259,157.00 plus a 10% contingency of \$25,915.70 if needed for staff approval of change orders for unforeseen conditions for a total expenditure of \$285,072.70.

Requested Action:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed Resolution No. R26-136.

Explanation of Request:

Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) lining is a trenchless method of placing a flexible lining into an existing pipe and utilizing heat and pressure to expand and cure the lining. The new CIPP lining extends the age of the existing pipe and provides a barrier to minimize groundwater inflow and soil infiltration into the stormwater pipes and pipe joints. Leaking pipe joints could potentially bring soil material into the pipe around the joint, causing potential depressions in the roadway. The Scope of Work detailed in the request for Bid includes the following general items: Task 1 - Pre-lining cleaning and video inspection, maintenance of traffic; Task 2- Pipe lining; Task 3- Post-lining video inspection. The Contractor will furnish all labor, materials, equipment, incidentals, and appurtenances to complete the defined work as outlined in the Contract Documents.

On June 2, 2026, Procurement Services, on behalf of the Utilities Department, issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 26-051B for the Campanelli Blvd. – Gateway Blvd. Stormwater Cured-In-Place Piping (CIPP) Project. The project consists of the installation of a cured-in-place pipe liner using a resin-impregnated, flexible tube method formed to the original conduit by means of a hydrostatic head, together with associated pipe cleaning and pre- and post-rehabilitation CCTV inspection, for stormwater pipes located in the Leisureville neighborhood (Campanelli Blvd./SW 22nd Street) and along Gateway Blvd. The scope includes lining approximately 220 linear feet of 12-inch pipe, 100 linear feet of 15-inch pipe, 500 linear feet of 30-inch pipe, and 350 linear feet of 48-inch pipe, together with all associated cleaning, inspection, traffic control, and restoration work.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference and site visit was held on June 8, 2026. The bid due and

public opening date was June 26, 2026, at 3:00 P.M., with submissions received electronically through the City's e-procurement system, bids&tenders. Nine (9) responsive bids were received and publicly opened in accordance with Section 255.0518, Florida Statutes.

Cobra Environmental Inc. of Jupiter, Florida, submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$259,157.00. The Utilities Department reviewed Cobra Environmental Inc.'s bid submittal and concurred with the recommendation to award, as documented in the User Department Concurrence Memorandum.

A Notice of Intent to Award was issued on July 21, 2026, identifying Cobra Environmental Inc. as the recommended awardee. In accordance with the Cone of Silence provisions of Section 2-355 of the Palm Beach County Code of Ordinances, as adopted by the City, the Cone of Silence remained in effect throughout the solicitation and continues in effect until the City Commission takes final action on this item.

Staff recommends approval and award of this ITB and contract for the Campanelli Blvd. – Gateway Blvd. Stormwater Cured-In-Place Piping project to Cobra Environmental, Inc., for a total contract value of \$285,072.70.

How will this affect city programs or services?

Lining of Stormwater pipes will increase structural integrity and life cycle as well as improve the flow capacity of the pipe, providing a better level of service and less likelihood of pipe failure and potential road depression or cave-ins.
