Proposed Resolution No. R26-127- Approving a Fire Rescue Department Emergency Services Agreement for Mutual Assistance and Automatic Aid between the City of Boynton Beach and the City of Delray Beach, Florida, for a ten (10) year term commencing October 1, 2026, and ending September 30, 2036; providing an effective date; and for all other purposes.

Requested Action: Staff recommends approval of Proposed Resolution No. R26-127.

Explanation of Request:

Section 252.40, Florida Statutes, encourages and authorizes political subdivisions of the State of Florida to enter into mutual aid agreements for the rendering of assistance in emergencies and provides for the extension of governmental powers, privileges, immunities, and benefits during such assistance.

How will this affect city programs or services? This agreement strengthens both Boynton Beach Fire Rescue and Delray Beach Fire Rescue's ability to respond to emergencies that may arise when Fire or EMS units are engaged in other emergency calls, necessitating assistance from a neighboring agency. Further, this agreement allows for continuity in Fire and Rescue activities that may occur that go beyond the capability of either agency.

Fiscal Impact: There is no direct fiscal impact on the utilization of Mutual Aid Agreements.
