BACKGROUND: The City annually contracts the Downtown Bozeman Partnership to administer the Downtown Business Improvement District.

FISCAL EFFECTS: As specified in its annual work plan and budget, the Downtown Business Improvement District (BID) pays a fee to the Downtown Partnership to cover the administrative costs of managing the district and implementing the annual work plan. The FY2027 Downtown BID work plan and budget was unanimously approved by the board on February 18, 2026 and presented to and approved by the City Commission on May 12, 2026.
