STRATEGIC PLAN: 7.3 Best Practices, Creativity & Foresight: Utilize best practices, innovative approaches, and constantly anticipate new directions and changes relevant to the governance of the City. Be also adaptable and flexible with an outward focus on the customer and an external understanding of the issues as others may see them.

BACKGROUND: At the December 2025 Inter-Neighborhood Council meeting, INC reps set top priorities for the upcoming year. A top priority being "Issue Advocacy and Policy Positions" and the Bozeman Creek work was identified as an area of interest in the brainstorm session.

The City of Bozeman adopted the [Bozeman Creek Vision Plan](#) as a priority in summer 2024 and adopted the [engagement plan](#) for the project in December 2025. The timeline for Community engagement is currently planned for February-May 2026. The Northeast, Bogert Park, and Bozeman Creek Neighborhood Associations, along with the Inter-Neighborhood Council were listed at key partners in the engagement plan.

Mark Campanelli, Bogert Park, will introduce the topic with some background and INC reps will discuss how interested neighborhood associations or INC as a whole should plan to be involved with the Bozeman Creek Vision Plan.
