STRATEGIC PLAN: 3.4 Active Recreation: Facilitate and promote recreational opportunities and active health programs and facilities.

BACKGROUND: In April 2025, the Downtown Bozeman Partnership applied for the Gallatin County's Open Space Levy grant program to augment the funding stack for the I-Ho Pomeroy Pocket Park. The I-Ho Pomeroy Pocket Park is a joint effort between the City of Bozeman and the Downtown Bozeman Partnership to memorialize the life, heritage, and contribution of I-Ho Pomeroy. This grant is one of two grants received for the pocket park.

FISCAL EFFECTS: Total expenditures funded by the grant are expected to be \$75,000. Expenditures will be made in the Parks and Recreation fund and may require a future budget amendment.
