RECOMMENDATION: Bikefill Community Park Update and Community Engagement Plan Discussion

STRATEGIC PLAN: 1.2 Community Engagement: Broaden and deepen engagement of the community in city government, innovating methods for inviting input from the community and stakeholders.

BACKGROUND: In July of 2025, the City of Bozeman and the Gallatin Valley Land Trust (GVLТ) signed a memorandum of understanding to create a new community bike park named Bikefill. The [Bikefill Community Park](#) project will feature non-motorized paved, gravel, and single-track trails as well as specially designed bicycle-specific terrain and skills features. In addition to Bikefill, there will be area improvements to McIlhatten Road. As part of the collaboration, the City is submitting a grant application to the MT FWP Land and Water Conservation Fund for financial assistance to construct a new parking lot and trailhead to service both Snowfill and the new Bikefill recreation area.

Staff will give a project update and present the community engagement plan for discussion.
