STRATEGIC PLAN: 4.5 Housing and Transportation Choices: Vigorously encourage, through a wide variety of actions, the development of sustainable and lasting housing options for underserved individuals and families and improve mobility options that accommodate all travel modes.

BACKGROUND: One Valley Community Foundation is the convener of the Regional Housing Coalition (RHC), a cross-sector group of diverse partners and resources that creates solutions to address the most pressing housing related needs in Gallatin County. RHC member include elected officials and public sector leaders, nonprofit affordable housing developers, homeless service providers, banks, realtors, employers, and more. The RHC is working to create housing solutions for some of our most at-risk populations.

FISCAL EFFECTS: \$50,000 in grant funding will be made available from the Community Housing division budget.
