**BACKGROUND:** Attached is a copy of Task Order Number 1 with Clear Route Real Estate, LLC

for the Right of Way Acquisition Project under the Professional Services Agreement for Streets and Utilities Land Agent Service FY2026-FY2028. This task order includes acquisition services to obtain land for the installation of

the Gooch Hill Lift Station.

The design phase services for the Gooch Hill Lift Station are included in the approved FY26 budget. The Wastewater Facility Plan calls for the lift station to be installed near the intersection of Harper Pucket Road and Valley

Center Drive. At this time, the City doesn't have any property in this area to install the lift station. This acquisition will be completed in two phases. The

first phase will review three different property locations near the

intersection to determine which will be the most suitable for the project.

The second will be to acquire the real property interests to allow the

installation of the lift station.

**FISCAL EFFECTS:** The proposed fee for this scope of work is paid on a time and materials basis

with a total cost not to exceed amount of \$9,530.00. The Gooch Hill Lift Station project is included in the FY26 approved budget at \$1,500,000.
