STRATEGIC PLAN: 3.3 Friendly Community: Ensure Bozeman continues to welcome diversity through policies and public awareness.

BACKGROUND: The Community Graffiti Removal program has historically been housed within the Streets and Engineering Department. With the implementation of the FY27-FY29 biennium budget cycle; this contract has been moved to the Neighborhood Services Department. The Community Graffiti Removal Program was established to report, document and remove graffiti within the City of Bozeman. Graffiti removal is a city-wide effort involving all City departments including but not limited to, Streets and Engineering, Parks, Police, Fire, Facilities, Parking and Code Compliance Division. Removal services are primarily focused on assets owned and operated by the City of Bozeman. Private Property Graffiti abatement may be requested/needed should a resolution with the responsible party not be reached with Code Compliance. This program is specifically designed to achieve the quality of life and inviting environment that the City of Bozeman and its community, expect and deserve.

FISCAL EFFECTS: Community Graffiti Removal has been budgeted for \$75,000, from the General fund within the Neighborhood Services Department.
