STRATEGIC PLAN: 1.3 Public Agencies Collaboration: Foster successful collaboration with other public agencies and build on these successes.

BACKGROUND: The Missouri River Drug Task Force (MRDTF) grant agreement is an annual grant agreement between the City of Bozeman and Gallatin County, the lead agency. This agreement fosters successful collaboration between public agencies to provide a safe, healthy city by working together to combat gang and drug activity. This funding agreement supports two police officers involved with the task force.
