BACKGROUND: The Montana Department of Commerce offers the Montana Main Street

Grant to members of the Main Street Program with local government

sponsorship. In collaboration, the Bozeman Downtown Partnership and the City of Bozeman submitted an application to revitalize a downtown pocket park located at E. Mendenhall Street and N. Black Avenue in honor of Commissioner I-Ho Pomeroy. If awarded, the goal of the project is to help preserve and celebrate an important piece of history. The project will recognize and honor I-Ho as a person, as a downtown businesswoman, I-Ho's South Korean heritage, and her efforts to promote a more walkable and

bike-able community. The total project cost is estimated at \$320,000 with a

grant request of \$256,000 and \$64,000 match.
