SUBJECT: Authorize the City Manager to Sign a Notice of Award to Bergkamp Incorporated for a Purchase Agreement for a 2025 Spray Injection Pothole Truck and a 2025 Flameless Pothole Patch Truck

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the City Manager to Sign a Notice of Award to Bergkamp Incorporated for a Purchase Agreement for a 2025 Spray Injection Pothole Truck and a 2025 Flameless Pothole Patch Truck.

STRATEGIC PLAN: 4.3 Strategic Infrastructure Choices: Prioritize long-term investment and maintenance for existing and new infrastructure.

BACKGROUND: This item is for procurement of STR112 and STR127 in the approved FY25-29 Capital Improvement Program and FY25 Biennium Budget. The equipment is a replacement of the Streets Division 2005 Freightliner Thermolay Patch Truck and 2014 Durapatcher Trailer Unit. These two pieces of equipment are used for Pothole Patching, Small Mill and Overlays, Cold Seam Repairs, Block Cracking, Fatigue/Crocodile Cracking, Edge Cracking, Rutting, Raveling and Multiple other distresses that are present through out the City.

Bergcamp Incorporated was the only Bidder with a Bid Price of \$673,279.80.

UNRESOLVED ISSUES: None

ALTERNATIVES: As Suggested by the Commission.

FISCAL EFFECTS: The FY25 Biennium Budget included \$620,000 in the Street Maintenance Fund for Item STR112 and STR127. The Bid Price is \$53,279.80 over what was budgeted. The Division has found operational improvement that will not require procurement of a Portable Emulsion Tank (STR110) for \$58,000 and savings from this item will cover the additional costs of STR112 and STR127.
