**STRATEGIC PLAN:** 1.1 Outreach: Continue to strengthen and innovate in how we deliver information to the community and our partners.

**BACKGROUND:** Staff from the city's Department of Transportation & Engineering and Bozeman Police Department will participate in a work session on traffic safety policy and progress since the adoption of Bozeman's Streets Are For Everyone (SAFE) Plan.

[Bozeman's SAFE Plan](#) was adopted in 2022 as a framework for holistic management of traffic safety on city-maintained streets. The plan is modeled after the [Safe System Approach](#) with the explicit goal of reducing and eliminating severe and fatal traffic crashes.

This work session will provide City Commission and the public with an overview of the SAFE plan, progress updates on accomplishments since plan adoption, and what activities are currently planned to advance our shared safety goals.
