**RECOMMENDATION:** Participate in the Long Range Transportation Plan update and provide input.

**STRATEGIC PLAN:** 1.3 Public Agencies Collaboration: Foster successful collaboration with other public agencies and build on these successes.

**BACKGROUND:** The Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is federally required to develop and maintain a Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The MPO procured Nelson\Nygaard and initiated the MPO's first LRTP in May 2025. The consultant team will present an overview of the Existing Conditions phase and solicit Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) input used to develop the vision and goals that will guide the next stage of work. The team has compiled baseline information across the region's major transportation elements, including population and employment trends, roadway and bridge conditions, safety performance, transit operations, multimodal network connectivity, and more. At this meeting, the consultants will summarize key findings and request TTAC feedback on priorities to confirm the technical foundation for alternatives development. Following Existing Conditions, the project will proceed to forecasting and alternatives development. This item is for information and discussion only; no action is requested.
