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SUBJECT: League of American Bicyclists 2025 Evaluation Summary

RECOMMENDATION: Presentation on the League of American Bicyclists 2025 Evaluation

STRATEGIC PLAN: 4.5 Housing and Transportation Choices: Vigorously encourage, through a wide variety of actions, the development of sustainable and lasting housing options for underserved individuals and families and improve mobility options that accommodate all travel modes.

BACKGROUND: In August of 2025 the City applied for review of our bicycle infrastructure, programs, and policies with the League of American Bicyclist through their Bicycle Friendly Community (BFC) program. The city received the results of this review in early 2026 and have prepared a presentation of the summary and next steps in order to expand and improve the bicycle network and advance to the next level of recognition. The City renewed its "Silver" status during this 2025 review process.

The League of American Bicyclists recognizes five categories of evaluation, including:

- Engineering
- Equity & Accessibility
- Education
- Encouragement
- Evaluation & Planning

The presentation will discuss the overall process of evaluation, results of the evaluation, and next steps or recommendations for the City to pursue in order to possibly advance to "Gold" status in the coming years. The current Silver designation is valid until 2029, at which time the City can choose to renew with an updated application and evaluation, or pursue a new, higher status.
