**RECOMMENDATION:** Authorize the City Manager to sign the Notice of Award for the Gallatin High Mid-Block Crossing project, to Duneman Construction Inc, for the Schedules I, II, and II-FF in the amount of \$148,514.80, and final contract documents once received.

**STRATEGIC PLAN:** 4.3 Strategic Infrastructure Choices: Prioritize long-term investment and maintenance for existing and new infrastructure.

**BACKGROUND:** Attached is a copy of the Notice of Award for the above referenced project. The project involves construction of a new mid-block crossing from Gallatin High School to the Bozeman Sports Park across West Oak Street. Also included is the removal and relocation of the existing HAWK (High Intensity Activated Crosswalk) signal located on Kagy Boulevard to the new mid-block crossing on West Oak Street.

Bids for the above-referenced project were opened on June 4, 2025, with 1 bid being received. The low bid was submitted by Duneman Construction Inc. in the amount of \$148,514.80. The engineer's estimate was \$158,652.50.00. The Engineers Award Recommendation, Notice of Award, and Bid Tabulation are attached.

**FISCAL EFFECTS:** This project will be paid from the Street Maintenance Fund. It was included in the FY25 approved budget as project STR103 at \$150,000.
