STRATEGIC PLAN: 1.2 Community Engagement: Broaden and deepen engagement of the community in city government, innovating methods for inviting input from the community and stakeholders.

BACKGROUND: City Advisory Boards operate from a two-year work plan that are connected to City Commission priorities. City Staff Liaisons to Advisory Boards are responsible for compiling the work plan with support from each Board. Staff held a work session with the Board in January 2026 to gather input on work plan items. Based on feedback received, the draft work plan presented in the work session has been amended to include an item on residential permit parking district boundaries.
