BACKGROUND: On March 28, 2014, a plat was filed titled South University District Phase 1

Minor Subdivision. On June 29, 2017, a plat was filed titled South University District Phase 2 Minor Subdivision. As noted on the plats, "...the lands included in all streets, avenues, alleys and parks or public lands shown on said plat are hereby granted and donated to the City of Bozeman for public use and enjoyment". One of the roads shown on both plats is Campus Blvd. It is being recommended to change the street name of Campus Blvd to Stucky Rd as it aligns with the existing portion of Stucky Rd. This change will provide consistency with our street network and follows Strategic Plan Item 3- A Safe, Welcoming Community, as well as Strategic Plan Item 4 – A Well

Planned City.
