Council to take action on Resolution No. 10-25 approving and adopting a Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026.

SUMMARY

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

It is a State law requirement that the City annually approve and adopt the Tentative Budget, to include estimates of revenues and expenditures. The Tentative Budget sets forth the financial resources plan for Buckeye Fiscal Year 2025-2026 service delivery programs and the CIP. After approval, the Tentative Budget and State budget forms will be available for public review and inspection. The Tentative Budget estimate for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 is \$819,669,500.

BENEFITS:

Satisfies the State law requirement to annually adopt a Tentative Budget and sets forth the financial resources plan for Buckeye's FY 2025-2026 service delivery programs.

FUTURE ACTION:

Publication of the Tentative budget Resolution and State budget forms once a week for two (2) weeks.
June 3, 2025: Public Hearing on the Final Budget
June 3, 2025: Adoption of FY 2025-2026 Final Budget
June 17, 2025: Adoption of FY 2025-2026 Property Tax Levy

The Tentative Budget estimate for FY 2025-2026 is \$819,669,500.
