**SUMMARY**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

One Story Social Dining is requesting approval for a Series 012 (Restaurant) Liquor License Application for their business located at 19580 W. Indian School Road #101 in Buckeye. The application and public notice were legally posted and the application has been reviewed and approved by required departments. The business is located in the Buckeye Planning area and will pay Buckeye taxes.
