ITEM TITLE: Adoption of a Resolution of the City Council extending the Mayor's Declaration of a local state of disaster issued February 4, 2023, and ratified by City Council on February 7, 2023, resulting from Winter Storm Mara experienced within the municipal boundaries of the city (City Manager Micah Grau)

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Honorable Lee Urbanovsky signed the proclamation declaring a local state of disaster in the City of Buda through February 6, 2023 and ratified by the City Council on February 7, 2023. The Emergency Management Director has requested an extension of the proclamation.

2. BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The Mayor of the City of Buda, Texas, pursuant to the authority conferred upon the Mayor by the Buda City Charter and Texas Government Code § 418.108, has the power to declare a local state of disaster within the City for a period of seven (7) days, to continue until February 13, 2023, subject to continuation or renewal by consent of the City Council. On February 6, 2023, the Mayor extended the declaration for 30 days and was ratified by the City Council on February 7, 2023.

3. ANALYSIS

Staff have reviewed the recommendations made by the state and county, therefore suggest extending the time frame another 30-days.
