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ITEM TITLE: Staff Report – Parks and Recreation Department Project Updates. (Tony Host Parks Director)

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Parks and Recreation Department will provide a staff report highlighting recently completed projects, ongoing initiatives, operational accomplishments, maintenance activities, and upcoming projects throughout the City's park system.

2. BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Buda Championship Park

The contractor has missed the interim and substantial completion dates by contract. We are working with the contractor to establish what is needed to bring the project to a completion.

Garison Park

Had the groundbreaking with a great attendance. The contractor has started to install erosion controls, surveying and clearing the area.

City Park Phase II-

Fencecrete has completed the install of the split rail fence. We will be doing a final inspection within the week.

Solar lights for the trail behind the wastewater plant will be installed by Aug 19th. Will do a final walk through on August 25th.

Citywide

- Soccer complex has been reopened and we have it filled. We are gaining a lot more interest for weekend play and are needing to make sure the fields get some rest time.
- Softball Fields are nearing the final completion date. We are actively pursuing tournaments and tournament companies to fill dates for FY 2027.
- Splashpad to be shutdown at city park Labor Day weekend. The installation of the new playground equipment will start immediately after.
- Staff finished repairing and re-routing irrigation lines in City Park due to the split rail fence installation.
