ITEM TITLE: Deliberation and possible action to consider a ballot for the Texas Municipal League (TML) Region 10 Director Election (City Clerk Alicia Ramirez) [PUBLIC TESTIMONY]

1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Each TML member city is entitled to one vote, which the vote must be cast by a majority vote of the city's governing body. The officials listed on the ballot have been nominated to serve a two-year term on the TML Board of Directors. A brief biography for each candidate is included.

Ballots must reach the TML office by 5:00 p.m. on October 3, 2024.

2. BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Regions exist to promote interests in city government on a regional level, facilitate the exchange of information among the cities in a region, and assist the Texas Municipal League Board of Directors in formulating policy that represents the diverse interests of the state.

Each region elects a representative to serve on the TML Board of Directors. The board representative must be an elected official from a city within the region and serves a two-year term of office with a maximum of two full terms. Each region may have only one board representative.
