## 1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Each taxing unit is entitled to vote may nominate, by resolution adopted by the governing body, one candidate for each position to be filled on the board of directors. The nomination must be submitted to the chief appraiser by October 15, 2024.

## 2. BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The appraisal district is governed by a board of nine directors. Five directors are appointed by the taxing units, three members are elected in the general election and the County Tax Assessor/Collector serves as an ex officio director. Members of the board serve two-year terms beginning on January 1 of even numbered years. The Hays CAD board of directors usually meets the third Thursday of every month at the district office in Kyle.
