Previous Action

May 27, 2025 (Item 5.a) – The Board of Supervisors approved the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2026, which included \$750,000 for the Project.

Background/Issues & Analysis

CWSD annually offers funding for projects that benefit the Carson River and the Carson River watershed. Carson City Public Works requested and was granted \$50,000 in funding from CWSD to assist with the design of the Bowers Lane Storm Drain Improvements.

The Project was identified in the North Carson City Area Drainage Master Plan (NCADMP), located in the eastern part of Carson City, primarily along Bowers Lane. Runoff from the Eagle Valley Golf Course crosses Arrowhead Drive and inundates the downstream neighborhood, which ultimately leads to ponding upstream of Highway 50. There is currently no storm drain infrastructure in this area; stormwater is conveyed by sheet flow and collects along the roads in front of properties.

The Project will be designed to convey 10-year flows via storm drain and open channels to the Carson River by intercepting flows at Arrowhead Drive and Bowers Lane. This aligns with one of CWSD's main goals of flood protection by reducing the impact of flooding to this neighborhood and getting water to the river.

Explanation of Fiscal Impact: If awarded, CWSD will grant Carson City up to \$50,000 for the design of the Project, and revenue and expense will be augmented for \$50,000. Total Project is estimated to cost \$750,000. There is currently \$481,565 in the budget for this project and \$370,491 available in infrastructure capital (undesignated). Note that \$305,491 will roll-forward from FY 2026 in January 2027.
