## **BACKGROUND**

## **DISCUSSION**

Sanitary sewer televising consists of cleaning the sewer pipes and recording video along the entire length of the pipe. The City typically performs this work in areas included in upcoming city projects. Storm sewer televising generally consists only of cleaning when debris levels prevent the camera from progressing through the pipe. The contractor will document and report any deficiencies observed during the video inspection.

The City of Chanhassen issued a request for quotes to five contractors on April 6, 2026, and received five responses. Quotes were evaluated based on total cost, including mobilization, sanitary sewer

cleaning and televising, and storm sewer televising. Based on the unit prices submitted, staff finds the quotes to be reasonable for the scope of work. The low bidder, Pipe Services, has previously completed similar work for the City of Chanhasen, and their performance was satisfactory.

### **BUDGET**

Funding for this work has been budgeted for in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), Project SS-012, and Project ST-012. \$48,301.00 of the funding will come from SS-012 for the portion of sanitary sewer televising and cleaning associated with the contract, and \$28,135.80 of the funding will come from ST-012 for the portion of the storm sewer televising.

Staff is proposing a not-to-exceed contract for 110% of the low bid, or \$76,436.80, in the event unexpected emergency services or quantity overruns are required.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends approving the sewer televising contract.
