SUMMARY

A permanent easement was needed over a small portion of the northeastern corner of the property to facilitate the reconstruction project - specifically the trail installation along the mini-roundabout at the Galpin Blvd & Brinker St intersection.

BACKGROUND

The construction of the improvements were made under a Right-Of-Entry agreement, and this agreement finalizes the consideration associated with the permanent easement acquisition process.
