SUMMARY

Consider an award of a design contract for annual well rehabilitation work.

BACKGROUND

The city has a plan for annual well rehabilitations. Typically, a municipal well is rehabbed every 8 to 10 years. The city currently has 12 active municipal wells. This project is for well no's 7 and 13. Well 7 was originally installed in 1996 and last rehabbed in 2018. Well 13 was originally installed in 2008 and last rehabilitated in 2017.

DISCUSSION

BARR Engineering has performed nearly all of our well installation and rehabilitation design services. They know our infrastructure and staff and have performed exemplary work thus far. The contract is based on our standard professional services template.

BUDGET

Well Rehabilitations are included in our 5-yr Capital Improvement Plan, which includes the design services. The budget for the 2026 rehabilitation work is \$180,000. BARR's proposal is for \$34,000 which is the basis for the not-to-exceed contract.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends awarding the design contract to BARR Engineering.
